DESTINY QUEST

A Student Guide

Destiny Quest is a brief book review that counts for a Language Arts writing grade. The review is entered into the Media Center's Destiny software and is made available online for the entire school population. One review is due per trimester and each must be completed and submitted in a timely manner. No late reviews will be accepted.

Each review must include a minimum of five (5) complete and correct sentences. Those sentences must include: title of the book and author's name; personal opinion of the book; brief summary of the book that does not give away critical parts of the plot; and the age or grade range that the reviewer thinks appropriate for the book.

Reviews will be graded prior to acceptance into the Destiny Quest database. Students should look to the rubric below for information on grading criteria. If a student's review remains unapproved, it is the student's responsibility to see the media specialist regarding their review.
