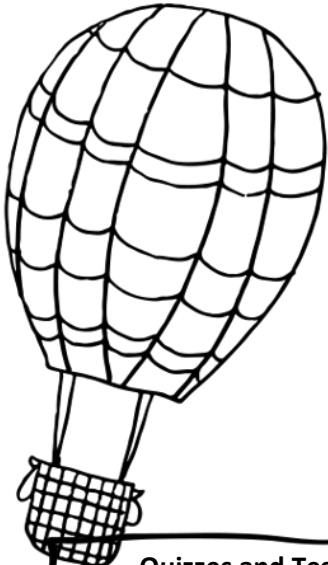


# : Fifth Grade :
