- Section 1, 2, and 3 will be reviewed and certain parts of each section will be highlighted and explained further: The decline of the Maya Civilization, The Aztec capital of Tenochtitlan, Aztec religion and warfare, Cultural achievements, Cortes Conquest, La Malinche, Government of the Incas, Pizarro's conquest of the Incas, Myths of the Spanish conquest.
- TLW get the opportunity to create their own Inca Quipus in class.
- TLW turn to Chapter 17 (p. 492): Section 1: Geography of Europe, Section 2: Europe after the Fall of Rome, Section 3: Feudalism and Manor Life, Section 4: Feudal Societies.
- TLW Individually work on an 3...2...1... activity. They will record three things they found interesting, 2 things they didn't find interesting and 1 thing they want to know more about.
- Within Section 2 the Vikings are briefly mentioned. The class will have a separate lesson on the Vikings.
- At the conclusion of the Viking lesson the students will get the chance to make their own Viking longships out of playdough.
- TLW turn to Chapter 18 (p.520): Section 1: Popes and Kings, Section 2: The Crusades, Section 3: Christianity and Medieval Society, Section 4: Political and Social Change, Section 5: Challenges to Church Authority.
- TLW Individually work on an 3...2...1... activity. They will record three things they found interesting, 2 things they didn't find interesting and 1 thing they want to know more about.
- Chapter 19: The Renaissance and Reformation: Section 1: The Italian Renaissance. TLW read through Section 1 (p.558-564)
- TLW discuss the Silk Road and how it brought different cultures and items around the world.
- TLW work on a Silk Road activity.
- TLW read through Section 2: The Renaissance beyond Italy (p.565-568)
- TLW read through Section 3: The Reformation of Christianity (p.569-575)
