A	Student earns Recorder Karate belt for given song	Student performs song with all correct rhythms & pitches; student performs song with a consistent steady beat; student performs song with a characteristic recorder tone; student demonstrates a complete understanding of notation, time signature, key signature, accidentals, dynamic markings & style markings.
B	Student earns Recorder Karate belt for given song	Student performs song with almost all correct rhythms & pitches; student performs song with a mostly steady beat; student performs song with a decent recorder tone; student demonstrates some understanding of notation, time signature, key signature, accidentals, dynamic markings & style markings.
C	Student earns Recorder Karate belt for given song	Student performs song with mostly correct rhythms & pitches; student performs song with a somewhat steady beat; student performs song with an average recorder tone; student demonstrates basic understanding of notation & time signature, very little understanding of key signature, accidentals, dynamic markings & style markings.
D	Student does not earn Recorder Karate belt for given song	Student performs song with few correct rhythms & pitches; student does not perform song with a steady beat; student does not produce a characteristic recorder tone; student demonstrates little understanding of notation, no understanding of time signature, key signature, accidentals, dynamic markings & style markings.
F	Student does not earn Recorder Karate belt for given song	Student is not prepared to perform the given Recorder Karate song.
