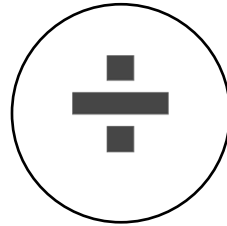
In order to maintain a positive learning environment, the following classroom rules are in place.

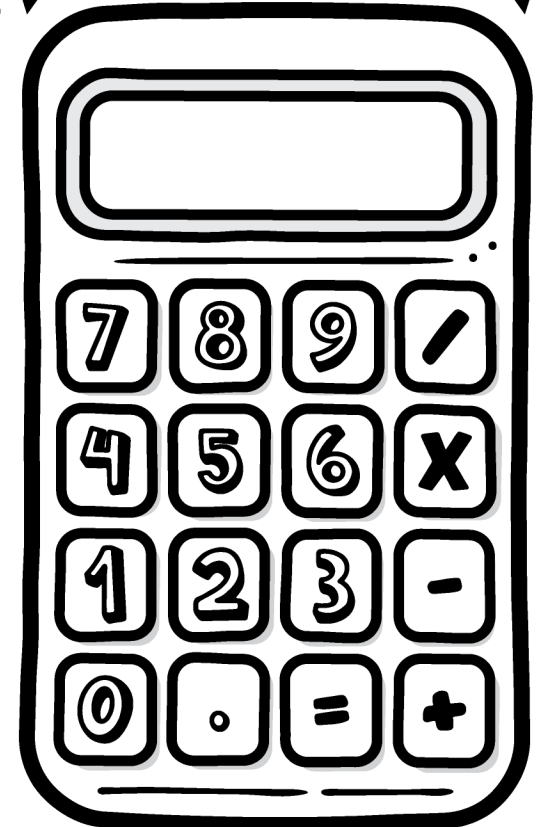

# HOMEWORK POLICY

- Homework will be assigned on a nightly basis.

# LATE WORK POLICY

- All assignments are due at the beginning of the class period on the assigned due date.
- Late homework will only be accepted the day after it is due, unless you are absent. (**you will receive half credit**).

# ABSENCE POLICY

- In the event of an absence, it is the students' responsibility to ask the teacher for any missed assignment.
- Each student will be given two days to turn in the missing work for every one day absent. For example, if a student misses three days, they will get six days to complete the missed assignments.
- If a student is absent the day an assignment is due, **they must** turn the assignment in the day they return to school.
