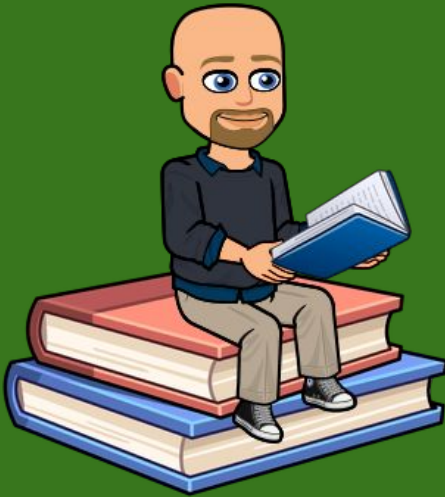

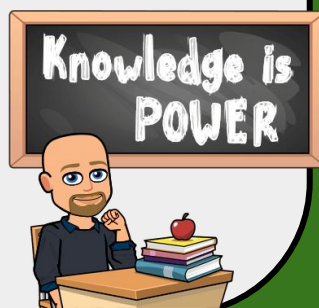
Course Overview

Academic Honesty

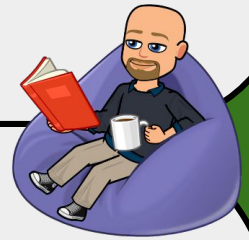
Academic dishonesty of any kind will result in a zero for the assignment. This means plagiarism, cheating, or passing off another student's work as your own.
