

Elementary Spanish Syllabus

Grade Level: 1st-2nd

Goals / Expectations: Goals for the first and second grade classrooms are to foster an appreciation for the Spanish language and cultures, begin to converse and answer simple questions in Spanish, expand their Spanish vocabulary both orally and written, explore literature and media through the Spanish language.

Assessment: Assessment is ongoing through participation in the classroom and classroom activities. Students will keep Portfolios throughout the year that will serve as an assessment as well. Some portfolio activities will be classwork assignments and occasionally a portfolio assignment will be assigned as homework. The students will have a culminating end of trimester assessment for the first two trimesters and a final end of year assessment.
