

## Spanish PK – 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

Welcome to Elementary Spanish!

The goal for this course is for students to learn and practice their Spanish. We will focus on pronunciation (3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade) and correct spelling of the elements the students are learning. We will begin with basic courtesy and greetings, the alphabet in Spanish, basic colors, and the numbers.

As the students progress during the course, I will start introducing different everyday life elements like the days of the week, months of the year, seasons, school elements, and members of the family, as well as how give and ask for basic personal information.

When the students come out of 4<sup>th</sup> grade, they are expected to know how to recite and read both the “Hail Mary” and the “Our Father” in Spanish, count from 1 to 100, and count from 10 to 1,000. They are expected to know how to engage in a basic conversation and ask as well as give their name, last name, where are they from, where they live, their phone number, and their email.

Every month we will explore a Spanish-speaking country. We will learn about their flag, special places that identify the country, the type of music and food, as well as holidays.

How will the students be graded?

- K – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students will be graded based on their participation and behavior in class.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students will be graded as follows:
  - Class participation/behavior 50%
  - Homework 25%
  - Tests 25%
